# **GRAPE VARIETY**

Cabernet Sauvignon

## **COLOUR**

Deep red with purple hues.

### NOSE

Aromas of spice notes, dark berry fruits and cassis.

Dark berry fruits with attractive blue fruit on the mid palate finishing with elegant and silky tannins.

# **VINTAGE CONDITIONS**

The 2019 vintage experienced warm ripening period ensuring perfect varietal expression.

#### WINEMAKING

Fruit was machine picked, fermented in stainless steel tanks with heading down boards, seeded with yeast, racked and returned daily. Grapes were then pressed to tank then barrel (16 months in oak), full malolactic fermentation, racked, light egg fining was added followed by light filtration then bottled.

# WINE ANALYSIS

Alc/Vol: 14.4% Acidity (TA): 6.46g/L

pH: 3.50

Residual Sugar: 0.31 g/L

# PEAK DRINKING

Drink now or carefully cellar for up to 10 years.

Pair with a roast rack of lamb ribs with lashings of mash potato and gravy.
